Wednesday, March 10 – *Horton Hears a Who*

Horton, the lovable elephant, tries to protect tiny creatures on a speck of dust.

Horton teaches us about how to treat others in the world.

Wednesday, March 17 – *Yertle the Turtle*

Yertle, king of everything he sees, attempts to build a bigger kingdom on the backs of his loyal subjects.

Yertle teaches us not to “step on” anyone on the way to the top because you might need them on the way back down.

Wednesday, March 24 – *Bartholomew and The Oobleck*

The King of Didd gets a surprise when he orders something “extra special” from his royal magicians – an “ooey-goey, green oobleck” to fall from the sky.

The young boy, Bartholomew, teaches the King and us the importance of admitting when you are wrong and saying you are sorry.

Wednesday, March 31 – *The Sneetches*

The Sneetches are a divided society where the “star-bellied” Sneetches think they are much better and more important than the “plain-bellied” Sneetches.

The Sneetches teach us a lesson about celebrating differences among us rather than using differences to create divisions.
