## July

6-8 **Bikes and the Beach:** We will be exploring Nantucket on bikes and enjoying our days playing on the various beaches. Bring your bike!!

13-15 **The Nature of Nantucket:** Naturalist led excursions throughout the various coastal ecosystems of Nantucket.

"From Beaches to Bogs and Back Again!"

20-22 **Your History:** In this session we will learn about the local history of the island; including early Native American, Colonization, Whaling, WWII, and more recent Nantucket history.

27-29 **\* On the Water:** This week will be all about water sports. We will spend a day taking surf lessons, a day kayaking, and a day sailing.

## August

3-5\* **Surf and Turf:** Spend a few days learning to ride horses and catching fish. We will spend a day learning all about caring for horses and how to ride them and two days learning to fish from the beach and from a boat.

\*there will be additional costs this week to cover horseback riding instruction and fishing equipment rental and licenses.

10-12 **\* On the Water:** Another session of surfing, kayaking, and sailing, only this time the water will be a little bit warmer, and the waves may even be a little bit bigger !!

\* there will be additional costs this week to cover surfing, sailing, and kayak instruction and rental.

17-19 **Bikes and the Beach:** Doing our best to maintain the Endless Summer we will be jamming as much beach fun as possible into this session.

Daily drop-off and pick-up will be at the St. Paul's parking lot.

All Proceeds from the camp will benefit the St. Paul's Youth Program.
